## FROM THE SCHOOL CONGRATULATIONS

Congratulations to 4<sup>th</sup> grade student, Caiden Butler, who was presented an Award of Recognition for an art piece she submitted for a contest. Caiden's submission will now become part of a statewide advertisement campaign for a program being hosted by the State of Kansas. The program was developed in response to recommendations of the President's New Freedom Commission on Mental Health to reduce the stigma of seeking care for mental illnesses as well as to develop a national strategy for suicide prevention. The goal of the campaign is to sharply reduce discrimination and stigma towards those in our society who suffer from, and to promote recovery of, all individuals with mental illnesses. Caiden's artwork will be used in a poster which encourages healing and recovery that will be distributed throughout the state as part of the anti-stigma campaign. Great job, Caiden!
